

****Gulf Breeze: Oil Spill Update****

May 10, 2010 72 Hour Forecast: No Oil Expected

Weather, winds and tides are holding the plume to the west and away from us for the time being. Possible change in direction Wednesday or Thursday

- City staff have picked up skimmer from Tennessee and are currently on their way back
- The waters around Dead Man's Island were boomed today
- Bioremediation, oil eating bacteria, was approved for use by BP
- A BP contractor will be in the Gulf Breeze area in the next few days working on boom laying strategies

Volunteers are needed to prepare "Oil Socks". If you are interested in helping please call 934-5115 between regular business hours and ask for Leslie.

Daily State Emergency Operations Conference call:

- Poor weather conditions hampered Gulf containment and burn activity
- Approximately 5,000 feet of boom were deployed today from Pensacola NAS, additional 10,000 feet arriving in the next few days
