

****Gulf Breeze: Oil Spill Update****

May 27, 2010

72 Hour Forecast: No Oil Expected

Current predictions still favor no landfall in the Florida area in the next 72 hours. Also, the plume is moving away from us, toward the west

- Mobile incident command has decided to move containment boom from Florida (Bay County) to Louisiana. Boom located in Gulf Breeze will stay in our area
- We continue to train and prepare our resources
- Current estimates are approximately 4 times larger than BP's original spill size estimate
- "Top Kill" results have been encouraging, but no definite results are available
- No further updates until next week are expected
