

## **\*\*Gulf Breeze: Oil Spill Update\*\***

June 9, 2010

72 Hour Forecast: No Oil Expected in Gulf Breeze; Santa Rosa Island / Pensacola Beach - tarballs are still coming ashore

- Oil in thicker amounts has begun to wash ashore in Perdido Key, much of it is in the tarball form. As such, we have no way to be 100% certain that tarballs have not entered Pensacola Bay. Therefore, we are asking that residents be vigilant for tarballs in our local waters, especially in the bay and near the Pass. If you see tarballs or other oil we ask that you report the time and location to **Police Dispatch at (850) 934-4050**.
- Gulf Breeze spill response team employees are walking the public beaches around the city every day in the early morning, late evening, and 3-4 hours after high tide in search of tar balls and other oily substances.
- If you spot indications of oil please report it to **Report Oil Sightings - 1-866-448-5816 with specifics (Location, Type of oil, Approx size or amount, time); please also report the sighting to Gulf Breeze Police Dispatch 934-4050**
- **As a side note, FDOT is installing traffic cams along I-10 east bound from Alabama to 87 over June 9-11. Expect lane closures**
