

## **\*\*Gulf Breeze: Oil Spill Update\*\***

June 11, 2010

72 Hour Forecast: Oil may be drawn in to Pensacola Pass this evening, we do not expect any Gulf Breeze landfall tonight. We expect to close the Bayous Saturday night. The City is constantly monitoring and evaluating tides, winds and the prospect for impact.

- As a precautionary measure, the state has authorized the boom across Pensacola Pass to be closed tonight at 7pm
- A large accumulation of oil has been found 9 miles outside of the pass and current weather conditions do not favor us.
- Gulf beaches continue to be under threat from oil impact
- If you spot indications of oil please report it to **Report Oil Sightings - 1-866-448-5816 with specifics (Location, Type of oil, Approx size or amount, time); please also report the sighting to Gulf Breeze Police Dispatch 934-4050**
- **As a side note, FDOT is installing traffic cams along I-10 east bound from Alabama to 87 over June 9-11. Expect lane closures**
