Mr. Jim Doyle, spoke regarding a half marathon he would like the City to sponsor to as one of the celebrations for the City's 50th Anniversary. He had at first suggested the half marathon be held in August but that is still a hot time of year and he suggested the run be held later in the year around Christmas time. The Mayor indicated she had spoken with the Anniversary Committee about the run and the Committee thought a half marathon was too long and suggested that a 5K run be held.
